A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF THE FRIEND AMBULANCE SERVICE, FOR A SPECIAL DESIGNATED PERMIT UNDER THE NEBRASKA LIQUOR CONTROL ACT, TO SELL LIQUOR, BEER AND WINE AT A FUNDRAISER FOR A NEW AMBULANCE TO BE HELD ON JANUARY 21, 2006 TO JANUARY 22, 2006 IN THE CITY OF FRIEND. THE SAID SPECIAL DESIGNATED PERMIT TO BE LIMITED TO THE INSIDE AREA OF THE FRIEND COMMUNITY BUILDING LOCATED AT 147 MAIN STREET FOR THE FRIEND AMBULANCE SERVICE FUNDRAISER FOR A NEW AMBULANCE TO BE HELD BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10:00 A.M. ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 21, 2006 AND 1:00 A.M. ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 22, 2006, PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, AND THE NEBRASKA LIQUOR CONTROL ACT.
