





## "RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY"

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA:

"Section 1. That the Mayor and Council deem and hereby declare it advisable and necessary to pass this resolution and to construct enlargements and additions to the existing sewage treatment facilities of the City at the present sewage plant site, and find that the said improvements will constitute a general public improvement in said City, which may properly be financed by the issuance of general obligation bonds of said City.

"Section 2. That said sanitary sewer improvements shall be constructed according with the plans, specifications and estimates of cost as prepared by the engineers for the City. Reference is hereby made to said plans and specifications, which plans, specifications and estimates of cost have heretofore been filed with the City Clerk and are hereby approved and adopted.

"Section 3. Such improvements to be constructed at the existing wastewater treatment plant shall include, but not be limited to, construction of one 70,000 gallon cast-in-place concrete sludge storage tank, two 4,000 gallon cast-in-place concrete sludge mixing tanks, installation of three submersible sludge pumps and two positive displacement blowers, and installation of aeration piping and diffusers within the new sludge storage tank and the two existing aeration basins, as well as all other necessary appurtenances thereto.

"Section 4. That for the purpose of the construction of the proposed improvements, there is hereby created in the City a sewer district to be known and designated as Sanitary Sewer District No. 2000-1, the outer boundaries of which coincide with and are the same as the corporate limits of the City.

"Section 5. That to pay the cost of the improvements herein provided for, the Mayor and Council will, after such improvements have been completed and accepted by the City, cause to be issued the negotiable bonds of the City to be called 'Sewer Bonds'. All of the said improvements are declared to be general public improvements and not local improvements and for the benefit of all the property in the City. All of said improvements are found and declared to be necessary and proper to furnish a sanitary sewer system for said City.

"Section 6. That the special engineers' estimate of the cost of such improvements is \$336,000.

The Saline County Board of Commissioners met with the Friend City Council on Tuesday, April 4, 2000 from 8:40 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. at the Friend City Hall. Those attending were Willis D. Luedke, Beth E. Mares, Phil F. Weber, commissioners; Bruce Filipi, high-way superintendent; Larry Lewis, high-way engineer; and Phyllis Ripa, county clerk.

Purpose of the meeting was to discuss with the Friend City Council the possibility of an interlocal agreement for hard surfacing of a four-block area on the east edge of Friend (Page Street). Discussion followed regarding block grants, state/federal funding, prior annexation, reclassification of road, traffic counts, drainage, right-of-way, utility relocation, engineering, grading, industry and preliminary costs of project. Lewis will compile additional figures using county labor for further review.
