RESOLUTION # 80-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AUTHORIZING PLACEMENT AND ENFORCEMENT OF YIELD SIGNS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend, Saline County, Nebraska, that Sixth Street which is an east and west street in the City of Friend, has been and is generally recognized as a thoroughfare from State Street to Main Street, and that traffic thereon should be protected from traffic entering from Cedar and Pine Streets by the establishment of yield signs directing north and southbound traffic on both Cedar and Pine Streets to yield to east and west traffic on Sixth Street.

The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Friend hereby direct the Street Commissioner to install and all law enforcement officers to enforce yield signs directing north and southbound traffic on both Cedar and Pine Streets to yield to east and westbound traffic on Sixth Street in the City of Friend.
