**ORDINANCE NO. 05-682**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-403 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA, REGARDING THE ALLOWABLE DATES AND TIMES FOR THE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS; AND ADDING ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS AT ALL TIMES IN AREA OF THE CITY PARK, TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA:

**Section 7-403 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, hold for sale, or offer for sale as distributor, jobber, or retailer any fireworks without first obtaining a license from the State Fire Marshall. Licensees shall only sell fireworks which have been approved by the State Fire Marshal and such permissible fireworks may be sold at retail only between June 24<sup>th</sup> and July 4<sup>th</sup> of each year. It shall be unlawful to discharge, explode or use permissible fireworks prior to June 24 of each year, or after July 4 of each year. During these dates, it shall be unlawful to discharge, explode or use permissible fireworks on any Monday through Thursday prior to 10:00 a.m. and after 11:00 p.m., and on any Friday, Saturday, Sunday or July 4th prior to 10:00 a.m. and after Midnight.**

**(2) It shall be unlawful at all times to discharge, explode or use any fireworks within the following boundaries of the City Park and municipal swimming pool area: between Chestnut and Maple Streets, 10<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> Streets.**

**(3) All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.**

**(4) This ordinance shall be in full force and effect and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.**
