


**RESOLUTION #10-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF THE FRIEND LEGION POST #183, FOR A SPECIAL DESIGNATED PERMIT UNDER THE NEBRASKA LIQUOR CONTROL ACT, TO SELL LIQUOR, BEER AND WINE AT THE LEGION'S PORK SUPPER TO BE HELD ON JANUARY 27, 2010 TO JANUARY 28, 2010 IN THE CITY OF FRIEND. 
