
A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF THE FRIEND AMBULANCE SERVICE, FOR A SPECIAL DESIGNATED PERMIT UNDER THE NEBRASKA LIQUOR CONTROL ACT, TO SELL LIQUOR, BEER AND WINE AT THE WARREN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL HOLIDAY PARTY JANUARY 6, 2006 TO JANUARY 7, 2006 IN THE CITY OF FRIEND. 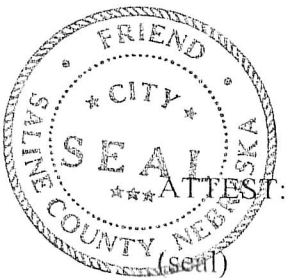
