

RESOLUTION NO. 97-14

WHEREAS, Nebraska law authorizes the Governing Body to set final property tax levies at different amounts than the preliminary levies certified to the Governing Body by the County Clerk;

WHEREAS, the Chairperson and Board of Trustees of the City of Friend, Nebraska, has conducted a public hearing as prescribed by law and heard and considered comments concerning the propriety of the preliminary levies and the need to establish a different levies;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend, Nebraska, hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Municipality that the General levy and Bond levy each be set at a different amount than that of the preliminary levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA, that the final levies of the Municipality of the fiscal year 1997-1998 are set at .468547 per one hundred dollars of actual valuation for the General Fund, and .049649 per one hundred dollars of actual valuation for the Bond Fund.
