

RESOLUTION NO. 95-3

COUNCILPERSON Smith introduced the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the City of Friend desires to establish a Clean Indoor Air Policy for the City; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City of Friend, Nebraska provide for the health and welfare and safety of its population and its employees, and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the best interest of its citizens and its employees that the practice of smoking should be prohibited in certain public facilities for the promotion of the health, welfare and safety of its population and its employees,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA, that smoking shall be prohibited in all municipal buildings and vehicles except those areas specifically designated for smoking by either the Council or various department heads. Smoking by City employees in designated areas shall be permitted only during authorized lunch and rest periods.

COUNCILPERSON Smith moved the adoption of said resolution.

COUNCILPERSON Tuttle seconded the motion. Upon vote the following Councilpersons voted aye Smith, Tuttle, Gill, Himmelberg, nay None, absent None. The Mayor declared the Resolution adopted.
