A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF THE FARMERS UNION COOP COMPANY OF FRIEND, FOR A SPECIAL DESIGNATED PERMIT UNDER THE NEBRASKA LIQUOR CONTROL ACT, TO DISPENSE BEER AT THE BUSINESS APPRECIATION SUPPER TO BE HELD ON AUGUST 29, 1992, IN THE CITY PARK OF FRIEND, NEBRASKA, THE SAID SPECIAL DESIGNATED BEER PERMIT TO BE LIMITED TO THE FENCED OFF AREA IN THE CITY PARK BETWEEN MAPLE STREET AND CHESTNUT STREET, WHICH FENCED OFF AREA INCLUDES A SIZE ONE HUNDRED (100) FEET BY FIFTY (50) FEET, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 5:00 O'CLOCK P.M. ON SATURDAY, AUGUST 29, 1992, TO 12:00 O'CLOCK MIDNIGHT ON AUGUST 29, 1992, PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, AND THE NEBRASKA LIQUOR CONTROL ACT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, that they hereby approve the application of the Farmers Union Coop Company of Friend, for a special designated beer permit for the fenced off area between Maple Street and Chestnut Street in the City Park of Friend, Nebraska, said fenced off area to be One Hundred (100) feet by Fifty (50) feet in size, for the business appreciation supper to be held on August 29, 1992, between the hours of 5:00 o'clock P.M. on Saturday, August 29, 1992, and 12:00 o'clock midnight on August 29, 1992, pursuant to the municipal code of the City of Friend, and the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.
