

A SUPPLEMENTAL TRAFFIC REGULATION RESOLUTION AMENDING THE RESOLUTION HERETOFORE PASSED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, RELATING TO TRAFFIC SIGNS AND MARKERS SO AS TO REQUIRE THAT NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC ON CEDAR STREET BE REQUIRED TO STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF SECOND AND CEDAR STREETS; THAT THE "YIELD" SIGNS HERETOFORE PLACED AT SAID INTERSECTION SHALL BE REPLACED BY "STOP" SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE TIME OF THIS RESOLUTION AND FOR PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT BY THE FRIEND POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ALL OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend, Saline County, Nebraska as follows, to-wit:

1. That the Resolution heretofore passed by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend relating to stop signs and other traffic control signs in the City of Friend, be and the same hereby is amended to provide that Northbound and Southbound traffic on Cedar Street in the City of Friend be required to stop at the intersection of Second and Cedar Streets; that the "yield" signs heretofore erected at said intersection be replaced by "stop" signs; that the above regulation shall be in force and effect from and after passage and publication according to law in the Friend Sentinel; that the Friend Police Department and all other law enforcement authorities be empowered to enforce said traffic regulation.
