

RESOLUTION 89-2


A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AMENDING THE RESOLUTION PASSED ON JANUARY 3, 1989, AND DETERMINING THAT CONGESTION AND DANGER TO THE PEDESTRIANS AND THE TRAVELING PUBLIC IN AND AROUND THE AREA OF THE FRIEND PUBLIC SCHOOLS EXISTS DURING WEEK DAY SCHOOL HOURS, BY REASON OF ALLOWING PARKING ON THE EAST SIDE OF MAIN STREET AND ON THE NORTH SIDE OF FIFTH STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH MAIN STREET. SUCH PARKING IS NOW DETERMIEND BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL TO BE A CLEAR AND PRESENT DANGER TO THE PEDESTRIANS AND TRAVELING PUBLIC, AND PARKING SHALL NOW BE PROHIBITED BETWEEN 9:00 O'CLOCK A.M. AND 5:00 O'CLOCK P.M. FROM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND that the area on the east side of Main Street between it's intersection with Fifth Street, Sixth Street, and the Street between the Friend Public Schools and St. Joseph's Catholic Church property, where two hour parking was allowed between 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., shall now be prohibited from 9:00 o'clock A.M. until 5:00 o'clock P.M. Monday through Friday. Furthermore, no parking shall be allowed on the north side of Fifth Street from its intersection with Main Street and 150 feet east thereof, from 9:00 o'clock A.M. to 5:00 o'clock P.M. Monday through Friday. The placement of signs so restricting parking is hereby authorized and the violation thereof is hereby declared unlawful and punishable as are other traffic infractions and other violations of City Ordinances of the City of Friend.

This Resolution offered on February 7, 1989 by Councilman Vossler and seconded by Councilman Smith. All Councilmen voting aye, the Resolution was passed and ordered and the City Clerk is authorized to notify all property owners affected by this change in parking, residing on the abutting streets.



SUCH PARKING IS NOW DETERMIEND BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL TO BE A CLEAR AND PRESENT DANGER TO THE PEDESTRIANS AND TRAVELING PUBLIC, AND PARKING SHALL NOW BE PROHIBITED BETWEEN 9:00 O'CLOCK A.M. AND 5:00 O'CLOCK P.M. FROM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY.
