RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL APPROVING IN PRINCIPAL THE PLAN OF MICHAEL BOWMAN, ADMINISTRATOR OF THE WARREN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, FOR SUBMISSION TO THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE WARREN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, WITH REGARD TO THE HOSPITAL BOARD AUTHORIZING LOANS TO BE MADE TO PROSPECTIVE NURSING STUDENTS UNDER THE CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS IN SECTION 17-572 R.S. 1983 OF NEBRASKA.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 17-572 R.S. 1983 of Nebraska, provides authority for Cities of the Second Class and villages, to contract with a person, including person's parent or guardian, if such person is a minor, to loan money to such person while such person pursues a course of study at an accredited college or university leading to a degree in specified medical services; that the Mayor and City Council feel that the intent of the statute is broad enough to include a degree in nursing, and recommends the plan of Michael Bowman, the Administrator of the Warren Memorial Hospital, to submit such a proposal to the governing Board of the Warren Memorial Hospital, for their further consideration.

2. The condition of such loans, if made, would be that the loan would be in consideration of the person's promise to practice nursing or the medical science authorized, in the City of Friend, and to repay the City of Friend for such money loaned during such person's study, after such person shall have been established in his practice or employment and upon such other terms and conditions as the Hospital Board may determine or warrant in the premises. If such person shall discontinue his course of study before attaining such degree, or fails to practice in or become employed in the City of Friend, after attaining such degree, and a license to practice is granted by the State of Nebraska, the City of Friend may pursue any remedy it may have against such person or his parent or guardian as in any other commercial transaction.
