RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, TO EXTEND THE HOURS OF THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ON SUNDAYS, FROM 12:00 O'CLOCK NOON TO 11:00 O'CLOCK P.M. BEGINNING ON THE 15TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1985 AND LASTING UNTIL NOVEMBER 15th, 1985 WITHIN THE LICENSED ESTABLISHMENTS UNDER THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, AND IN PARTICULAR FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FRIENDLY LANES BOWLING ALLEY WHOSE PATRONS PARTICIPATE IN A MIXED LEAGUE ON SUNDAY EVENINGS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend, Nebraska, that they hereby agree to an extension of the hours of the sale of alcoholic liquor on Sundays from 12:00 o'clock Noon to 11:00 o'clock P.M., beginning on the 15th day of September, 1985 and lasting until the 15th day of November, 1985; that the purpose of this Resolution, in particular, is for the benefit of the Friendly Lanes Bowling Alley to accommodate their patrons who participate in the Mixed League on Sunday evenings.
