

RESOLUTION NO. 81-7

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, SALINE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, ESTABLISHING CURRENT STANDARD RATES WITH REGARD TO COGENERATION FACILITIES, PURSUANT TO SECTION III, "RATES FOR SALES OF ELECTRIC ENERGY TO QUALIFYING FACILITIES" AND SECTION IV, "RATES FOR PURCHASES OF ELECTRIC ENERGY FROM QUALIFYING FACILITIES" UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 441 PASSED AND ADOPTED ON MARCH 3, 1981.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Resolution shall apply to cogeneration facilities for the purchase of power and energy by the City of Friend from small power and energy producers with production capabilities of less than 100 KW, without time of day metering at the same rate that the City of Friend buys electric energy from Nebraska Public Power District. The producer shall be required to pay a minimum monthly charge to the City of Friend for each metered interconnection and this minimum charge shall be: \$ 2.00 per meter per month for single phase meter installations. \$ 2.00 per meter per month for three-phase meter installations.

Furthermore, the terms and conditions thereof will be that the owner of the small power and energy production facilities must execute a small power and cogeneration agreement with the City of Friend pursuant to Ordinance No. 411 of the City of Friend for standby or supplemental use to cogenerator. The City will use the applicable rate schedule for the class of service of the cogenerator.

2. The purchase of power and/or energy by the City of Friend from small power and energy producers with production capability of more than 100 KW shall be at the same rate per KWH as the City of Friend pays to the Nebraska Public Power District for retail power and energy purchases.

A minimum charge per month where there is time of day metering will be \$ 2.00 per meter per month for single phase meter installations and \$ 2.00 per meter per month for three phase meter installations.

Terms and conditions of this shall be the same as required under Section I above.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
