

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE RESOLUTIONS HERETOFORE PASSED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRIEND, RELATING TO TRAFFIC SIGNS AND MARKERS AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE TIME OF THE RESOLUTION AND FOR EFFECTIVE DATE OF ENFORCEMENT BY THE FRIEND POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ALL OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend, Saline County, Nebraska as follows, to-wit:

1. The Resolutions heretofore passed by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Friend relating to stop signs and other traffic control signs in the City of Friend, be and the same hereby are amended to provide for the following stop signs in addition to all those previously authorized, to-wit:

(a) That north bound and south bound traffic on Main Street be required to stop at the intersection of Fifth and Main Streets, as directed by a folding stop sign on such days and during such hours as the school authorities open the stop sign to an observable position where the word "Stop" can be plainly seen by oncoming traffic.

2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication according to law in the Friend Sentinel.

3. The Friend Police Department and all other law enforcement authorities are hereby authorized and directed to enforce such traffic regulation from and after the date of publication.
