Mayor Knoke led the pledge of Allegiance.

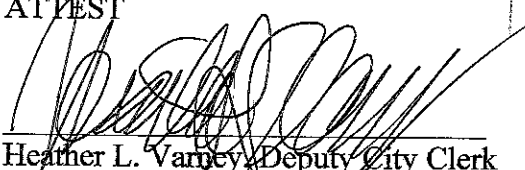
Public Comments none.

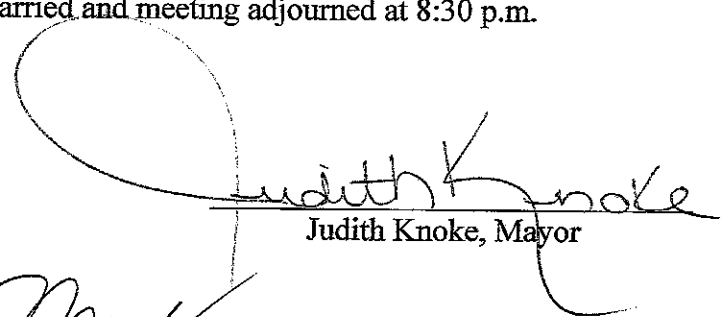
Councilmember Sladek and Public Works Supervisor Billy Baugh arrived at this time.
