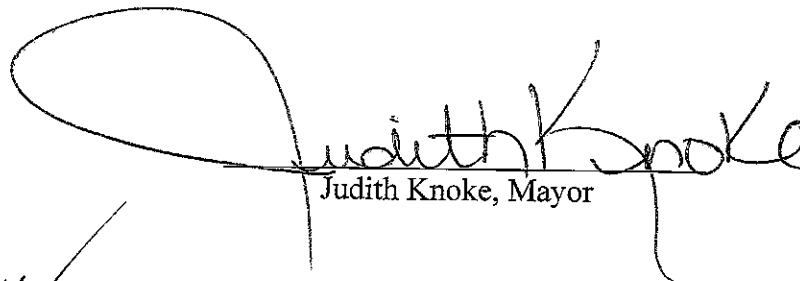

Public Comments none.

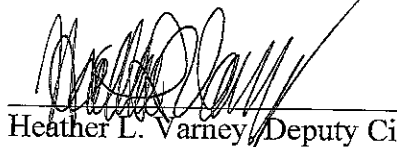
